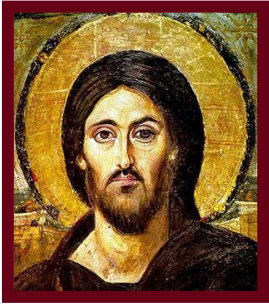

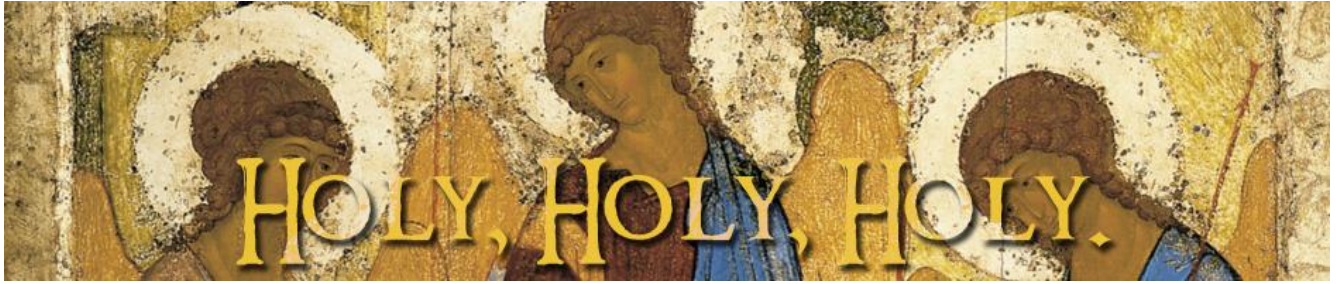

The *Amherst Early Music Festival* brings over 50 professional early music performers and teachers from across the world to teach and perform. The festival concert series includes a fully staged baroque opera, as well as performances by the Flanders Recorder Quartet, Julianne Baird, and Glen Velez. Amherst Early Music is the largest presenter of Early Music workshops in North America.

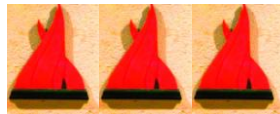
